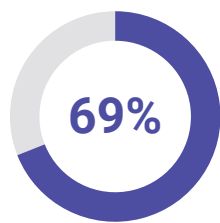


Medicare Annual Wellness Visit Telehealth Survey Says...

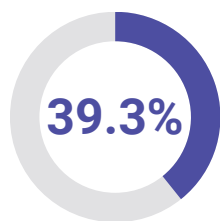
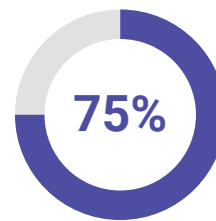
The majority of Medicare enrollees who previously have had a telehealth visit would be comfortable doing annual wellness visits (AWVs) via telehealth from home, revealed a February 2024 survey of 400 Medicare patients sponsored by KeyCare.

Here are 5 numbers to know:



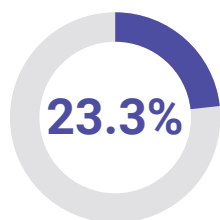
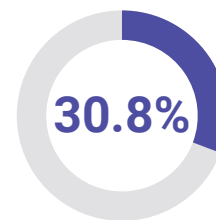
69% of Medicare enrollees who previously have had a telehealth visit would be comfortable doing **AWVs via telehealth from home**

75% feel comfortable conducting AWVs with a provider who is not their primary care physician - **if their medical records could be shared across providers**



39.25% cited convenience in terms of **transportation and time** as the greatest benefit of telehealth AWVs

30.75% cited elimination of **the need to sit in an office with sick people** as the greatest benefit of telehealth AWVs



23.25% cited **lower expenses** as the greatest benefit of telehealth AWVs
